#### CHAPADA - ACQUISITION

BBX advises that it has settled the final payment of A\$110,000 due to Mundo Mineracao Ltda, for 51% of the Chapada Mineral Right under the agreement dated 21 October 2011, and amended on 2 February 2012, 27 July 2012, 11 October 2012 and 28 March 2013.

BBX has issued 4,000,000 fully paid ordinary shares to Mundo Mineracao Ltda @ 2cents being a 20% discount to the last traded share price, and paid A\$30,000 cash in settlement of its obligations.

The Company will rely on its available 15% capacity as defined in ASX Listing Rule 7.1 and will not seek shareholder approval for the issue.

The Company has agreed to lodge a cleansing prospectus within 5 days of issuing the shares.
